

STUDENT MINISTRY GUIDELINES

1. All students are expected to display an attitude that reflects their love of Christ and is in accordance with Biblical principles. All students are expected to be respectful to their leaders and peers at all time.
2. All students are expected to be on time for each event. Being tardy will delay the group and shows disrespect for the group leaders.
3. All students are expected to remain in the designated areas. All students are expected to have permission from a leader and be accompanied by a friend before leaving a designated area.
4. All students are expected to remain with the group. During specified events such as swimming, you must have a partner at all time.
5. All students are expected to respect and maintain the grounds, hotels, equipment and other furnishings of the church and all places of lodging. Repair for damages will be the financial responsibility of the parents.
6. All students are expected to dress in a manner that exemplifies Christ. During water activities, young ladies are asked to wear a modest one-piece or tankini swim suit that covers the whole mid-section. Our student staff may ask a teenager to wear a t-shirt over their suit if necessary.
7. All students are expected to abide by the lodging rules. These rules include being in your own room by the set curfew time and remaining there until dismissed by your leader. No guys are allowed in the girls' room or vice versa unless there is an adult present or the room door remains open.
8. Please bring music that is appropriate for a Christian outing. The student staff will monitor the music if needed.
9. All students are expected to refrain from the use of tobacco, alcohol, or any drug products during any outing, trip or function of the church. Failure to do so will result in the immediate dismissal of the student from the activity or event at the parent's expense.
10. All students are expected to refrain from both private and public displays of affection with members of the opposite sex. Let your parents guide you in this area.
