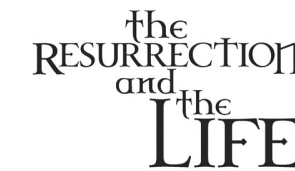
The **Bells of Grace** would love for you to join them. A few more ringers will complete our handbell group. Join us in Room 214-A each Wednesday at 5:30 PM.
